TITLE: Committee of Small Operators.

DESCRIPTION OF ACTION: [Provide a brief description up to 500 words]

The Institute elaborated a first draft of the Rules of Operation of the Small Operators Committee, which the Governing Board of the Institute approved to submit to the public consultation process, in its Internet portal, for a period of 20 working days, that is, from October 28 to November 25, 2022.

This Committee aims to have a space with small operators, to address the needs, proposals, concerns, and real problems that these companies suffer, such as:

- Deregulation and administrative simplification.
- Analyze the implementation of light regulation schemes (soft law).
- Establish new mechanisms to access the network of large operators.
- Accessibility of information on active and passive infrastructure and their points of presence.
- Attention to training needs in regulatory and technical issues that allow them to take better advantage of their network.
- Such as issues related to new technologies, compliance with obligations, and use of the Institute's electronic systems.

The Committee will allow to know and understand the proposals and concerns of the small operators on topics such as: regulation improvement, administrative simplification, detection of new technologies or training needs, and the incorporation of measures to stimulate quality in the provision of its services. Therefore, the main challenge was to establish the parameters, characteristics, and appropriate considerations to determine what will be understood by a small operator.

For these reasons, the Institute is strengthening the proposal of this Committee, through the realization of focus groups that have affected the completion date of the project.

In the first quarter of 2023, the Institute held working meetings with relevant stakeholders of the telecommunications sector to present the draft Rules. In this sense, through the socialization of the project, we will be working on the construction of the last version of the project.





The goal is to submit the final version of the rules to the consideration of the Plenary of the Institute during the fourth quarter of 2023.
