TITLE: Empowerment of Users in Indigenous Languages.

**DESCRIPTION OF ACTION:** [Provide a brief description up to 500 words]

The Empowerment of Users in Indigenous Languages was implemented in 2022, to continue to strengthen the development, preservation, and use of national indigenous languages, as well as promoting access to telecommunications services and the empowerment of users. 150 materials were translated into the 10 indigenous languages of the north of the country, bringing the total number of informative materials translated into 32 indigenous languages to 356 with the last two annual editions.

This program is part of the series of actions that the IFT has carried out to promote that indigenous peoples and communities are better connected, informed, and aware of their rights as users of telecommunications services, among which we can highlight the issuance of diagnostics that identify the locations with indigenous population that have access to mobile service coverage in at least one technology (2G, 3G or 4G).

It participated in the National Indigenous Languages Fair (FLIN), where we provided information about the rights of users, the tools that the IFT has designed and how they work, in addition to exhibiting the informative materials that have been translated into various indigenous languages during the previous workshops held.

The implementation of the Program involved coordination with authorities interested in promoting the empowerment and rights of users of telecommunications services within the scope of their powers.

With this, progress has been made in complying with the provisions of the General Law on Linguistic Rights of Indigenous Peoples (LGDLPI), to guarantee and respect the linguistic rights of indigenous peoples, and to promote their digital literacy. Furthermore, the informative materials generated within the program have served as input for other entities and institutions to inform the population about their telecommunications rights.





The results of the program were reflected on the website called Indigenous Peoples and Communities, <u>https://www.ift.org.mx/comunidades pueblosindigenas</u>, where the information and materials produced during the year were published.
