DESCRIPTION OF ACTION: [Provide a brief description up to 500 words]

The Program to Promote Trust in the Digital Ecosystem Project was implemented in 2022, with several activities related to generating a culture of cybersecurity and informing users about the safe use of telecommunications services and trust in the digital environment.

The Program aimed to promote coordinated actions with the various actors and authorities that participate in the digital ecosystem and have common objectives to program and implement actions in digital literacy, promote a culture of cybersecurity, trust, and responsible use of Internet access, which could give an improvement in cybersecurity preparedness/resilience with key capabilities.

To achieve this objective within the program, activities were defined as follows:

- Establish working meetings for the definition of specific actions.
- Carrying out coordinated actions for the development of informative materials.
- Jointly program the dissemination of materials on specific and current topics, previously defined by the program participants.
- Jointly teach courses, workshops and conferences to the public and/or specific audiences.
- Share knowledge and exchange information or opinions with other authorities based on the activities carried out by the program.

With the actions and activities carried out under the Program to Promote Trust in the Digital Ecosystem, information was made available and generated for the benefit of users of telecommunications services with the aim of promoting safe use when surfing the Internet, using digital platforms and the services provided through them.

Likewise, because of the work meetings that the Institute held with the different authorities, organizations, and institutions, it was possible to exchange information materials, ideas, projects, workshops, and conferences that each of the agencies and private entities have developed in cybersecurity. In addition, collaboration, planning, and execution links have been established to



achieve the Program's objectives and, thus, achieve short-term results that produce a significant change in the way users interact in the digital environment.
