- Organize a kickoff workshop to launch activities in this RI (Egypt, 20-21 April 2015)
- Translate and publish and share ITU Model ICT Accessibility Policy report

Development of ICT applications and software that enable persons with disabilities to access information, references and other resources for education and leisure, and provision of specialized national and regional applications for libraries, databases and other purposes via the Internet and other telecommunication/ICT media

- Formulate and launch project to establish a regional innovation center on Accessibility
- Develop online curriculum for the ITU Model ICT Accessibility Policy modules for delivery through ITU Academy
