Security and Access to Event Premises

- Access to the Official Event premises within the Kempinski Hotel Muscat will be strictly limited to persons wearing an Event Badge.

Arabic is the official language of Oman. English, Hindi, Swahili are among the other languages widely spoken.

Weekly Holidays: Friday - Saturday

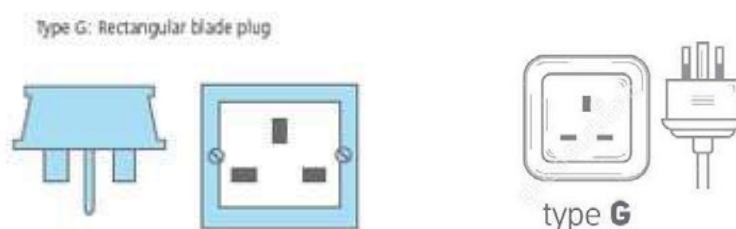
