


United Nations Specialized Agency for Telecommunications/Information and Communication Technologies (ICTs)

Growth of mobile-broadband subscriptions, CAGR, 2012-2017








Al-powered technologies deployed on 6 billion smartphones by 2021




IoT technologies expected to connect 50 billion devices to the network by end 2020

Connected Car via VISA / Master card / Ali Pay




According to Gartner, some 250 million connected cars worldwide will be on the road by end 2020.
