



Results from Implementation of Operational plan 2018

- 34 activities were implemented for an amount of USD 450 K (Operational Budget)
- 10 ongoing Projects valued at (USD 6.6 M)
- 13 CoEs courses were implemented
- More than 1000 participants (around 500 females) attended the regional activities including training activities.
- 2 cooperation agreements signed with partners


Some of our 2018 events
