This 2-days online workshop will highlight the benefits of using the <u>Common Alerting Protocol (CAP)</u>, which is a standard for exchanging all-hazard emergency alerts and public warnings over all kinds of ICT networks, provide an opportunity to learn the advantages of developing <u>Table-Top exercises</u>, and raise awareness on the importance of the <u>Tampere Convention</u>.

This online workshop targets policy makers from ministries of ICTs, ICTs regulators, disaster management organizations, red crescent and red cross organizations, private sector entities, United Nations agencies, non-governmental organizations and other participants from humanitarian organizations, as well as academic institutions and media.
