We are pleased to invite you to participate in the “**Regional Training Workshop on Spectrum Monitoring for the Arab Region**”, which will be held online during the period from **9 to 12 November 2020** between **10:00 - 13:30 Cairo Time**. The workshop will be conducted in English.

As spectrum monitoring is an essential tool for spectrum management for its ability to monitor and measure, detecting and identifying unauthorized stations, determining the location of stations for further enforcement actions and identifying the source of harmful interference, this capacity building workshop aims to provide insights into the role, function and techniques of spectrum monitoring. It gives an understanding to the purpose and capabilities of different types of spectrum monitoring equipment as well as basic spectrum monitoring and measurements.

In addition, it will provide an overview of the ITU-R Handbook on Spectrum Monitoring, the ITU-R Recommendations and Reports, the ITU Radiocommunication Bureau programs in this area. It will highlight the ITU Academy Spectrum Management (SMTP) Training Program on Spectrum Monitoring.

This workshop is designed to address mid to senior level management from policy makers, regulators, corporate executives and managers undertaking spectrum management responsibilities in their respective organizations and especially in the field of spectrum monitoring. Participation in this training workshop is open to ITU Member States, Sector Members, Associates and Academic Institutions as well as other relevant stakeholders.
