I am pleased to invite you to attend the ITU Regional Workshop “Towards Universal and Meaningful Connectivity for Arab Region”, organized by the Telecommunication Development Bureau (BDT) of the International Telecommunication Union (ITU) in collaboration with Algérie Télécom, under the high patronage of the Ministry of Post and Telecommunications. This workshop will be held from 11 to 12 November 2024 in Algiers, Algeria at Ecole Supérieure D'hôtellerie et de Restauration (ESHRA). The working language will be English and interpretation in Arabic and French will be provided for both on-site and remote participants.

This workshop aims to familiarize the ITU memberships in the Arab region as well as representatives of the telecommunications industry and specialists in the field of digital infrastructure with the various ITU infrastructure portfolios, including ITU global and regional initiatives. This would support countries to map broadband infrastructure and provide them with tools and practices to identify gaps related to infrastructure, the most promising options for infrastructure connectivity enhancement, increase human potential, as well as the choice of appropriate technology with the lowest CAPEX, give an overview of business planning of connectivity projects to ensure their viability by key representatives of the industry, as well as the development of targeted recommendations for the further formation of partnerships in this field. Therefore, engage investors for collaboration to bridge the connectivity gaps.

The event will offer a valuable platform to connect Member States and policymakers, the tech industry and private sector's representatives, with development organizations including development banks, UN agencies, researchers, education institutions, and media among others.
