- Integrated Drug Test Operations and Management Information System (DOH)

Use of SMS for auto notification of accreditation status, activities, and requirements



mHealth Applications



- Surveillance in Post and Extreme Emergency and Disasters or SPEED (DOH and WHO)

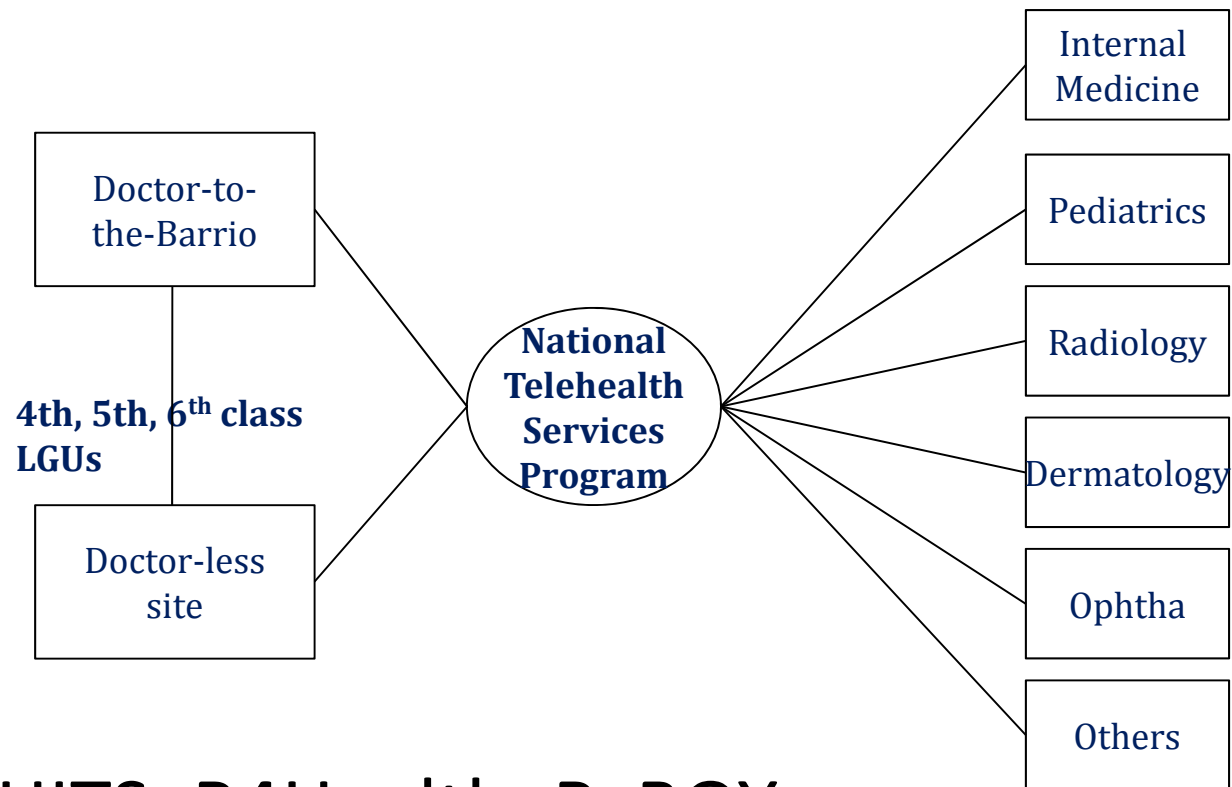
Provide real time health information reporting after a disaster

- Telemedicine (UP-NThC, DOST, UNICEF, and DOH)
Use of cellphones to collaborate with health care providers, specialists, and other health workers.

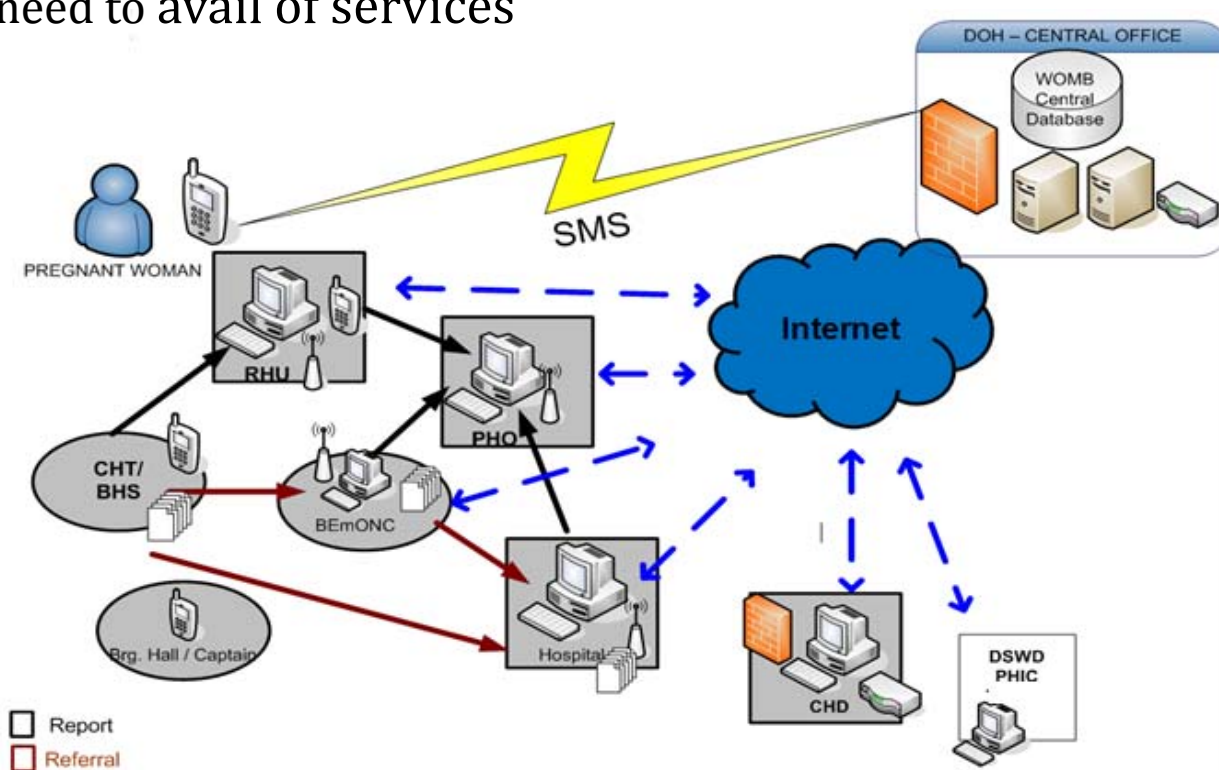
mHealth Applications



- Watching Over Mothers and Babies (DOH)

A Maternal and Neonatal Health Tracking System

- Enrolls expectant mothers and their neonates, to schedule and record health services provided and monitor their progress
- Prompts to remind mothers or any member of their household or community of the services that the pregnant women and eventually her child need to avail of services

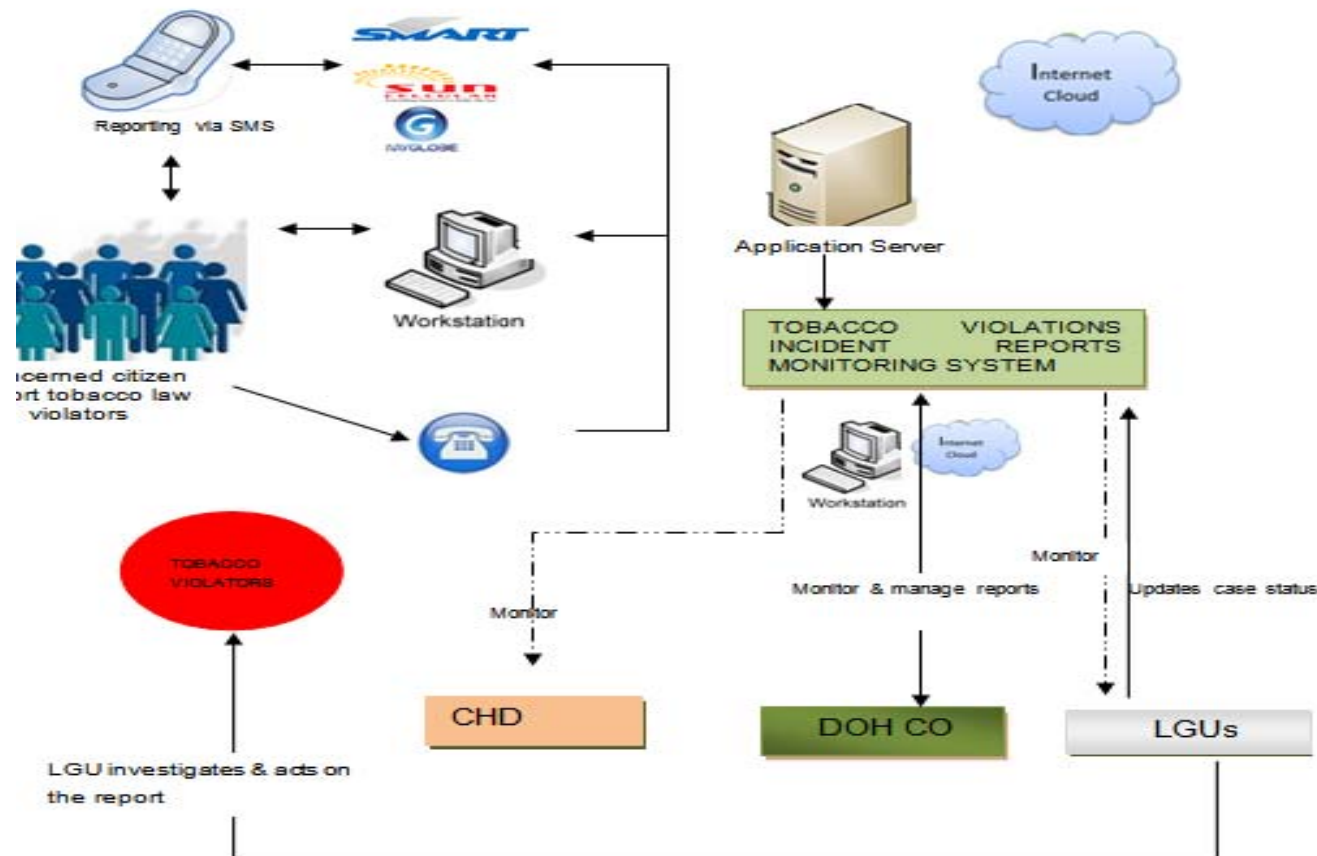


mHealth Applications



- Smoke Free Philippines (DOH)

Reporting of tobacco violations via SMS, other than online and hotline

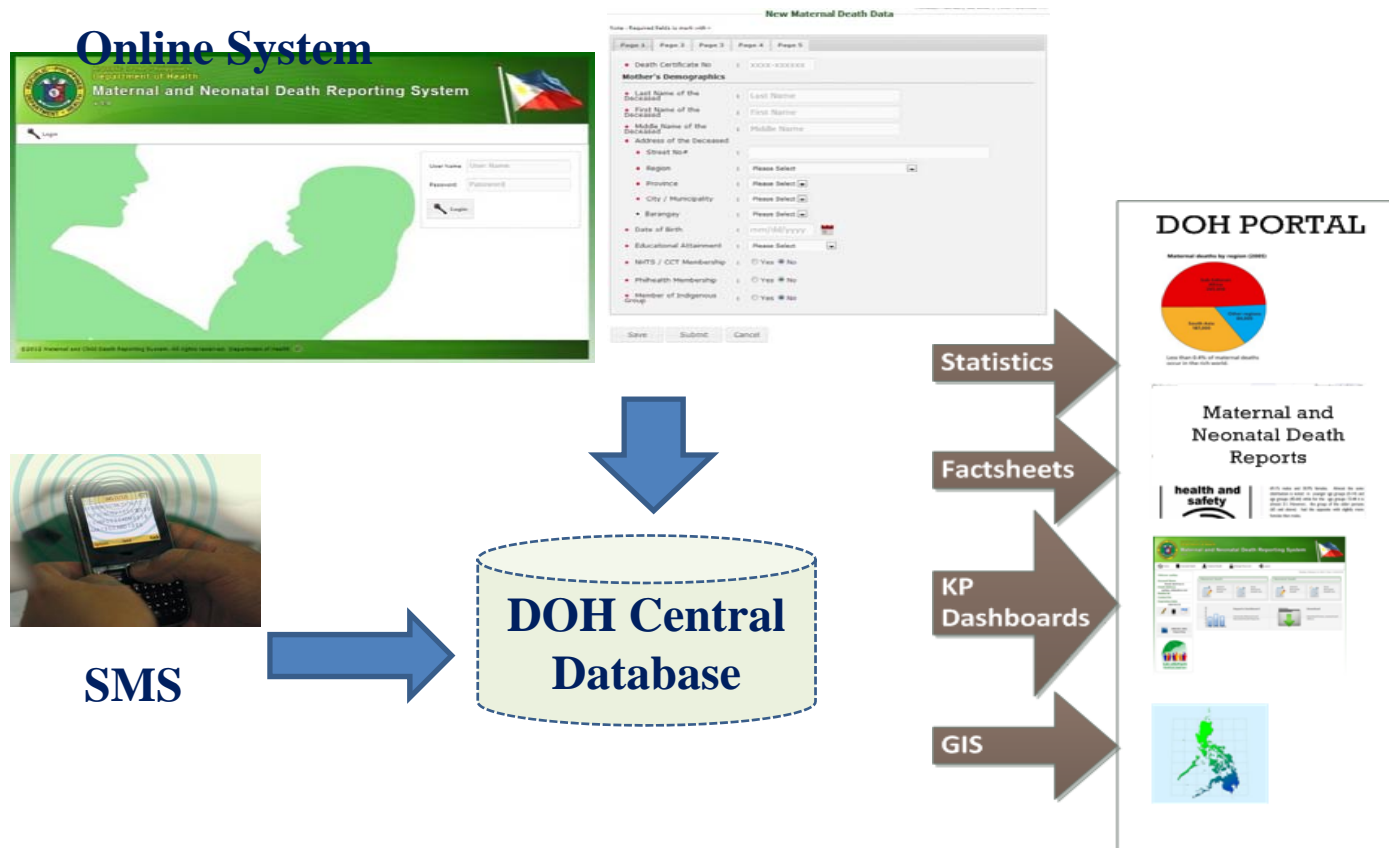


mHealth Applications



- Maternal and Neonatal Death Reporting System (DOH and WHO)

A system for reporting of maternal and neonatal deaths using internet and SMS Technology.

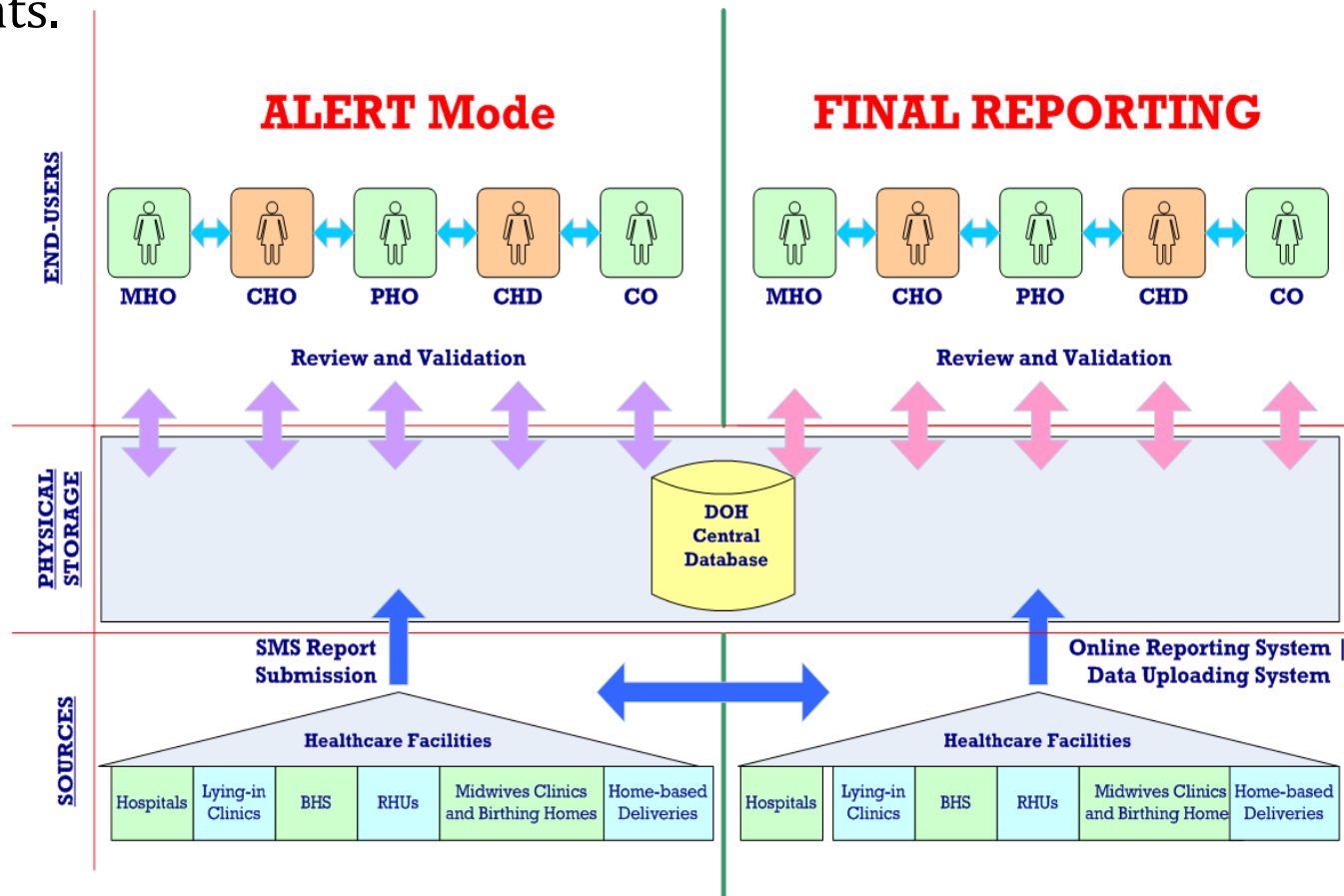


mHealth Applications



- Integrated Clinic Information System – Alert and Reminder System (DOH)

Uses SMS/mobile Technology for alerts and reminders of schedules to patients.

- Data Collection System via online
 - Online National Electronic Injury Surveillance System
 - National Online Stock Inventory System
 - Unified Chronic Non-communicable Disease Registry System
 - Online Field Health Services Information System
 - HIV/AIDS Registry

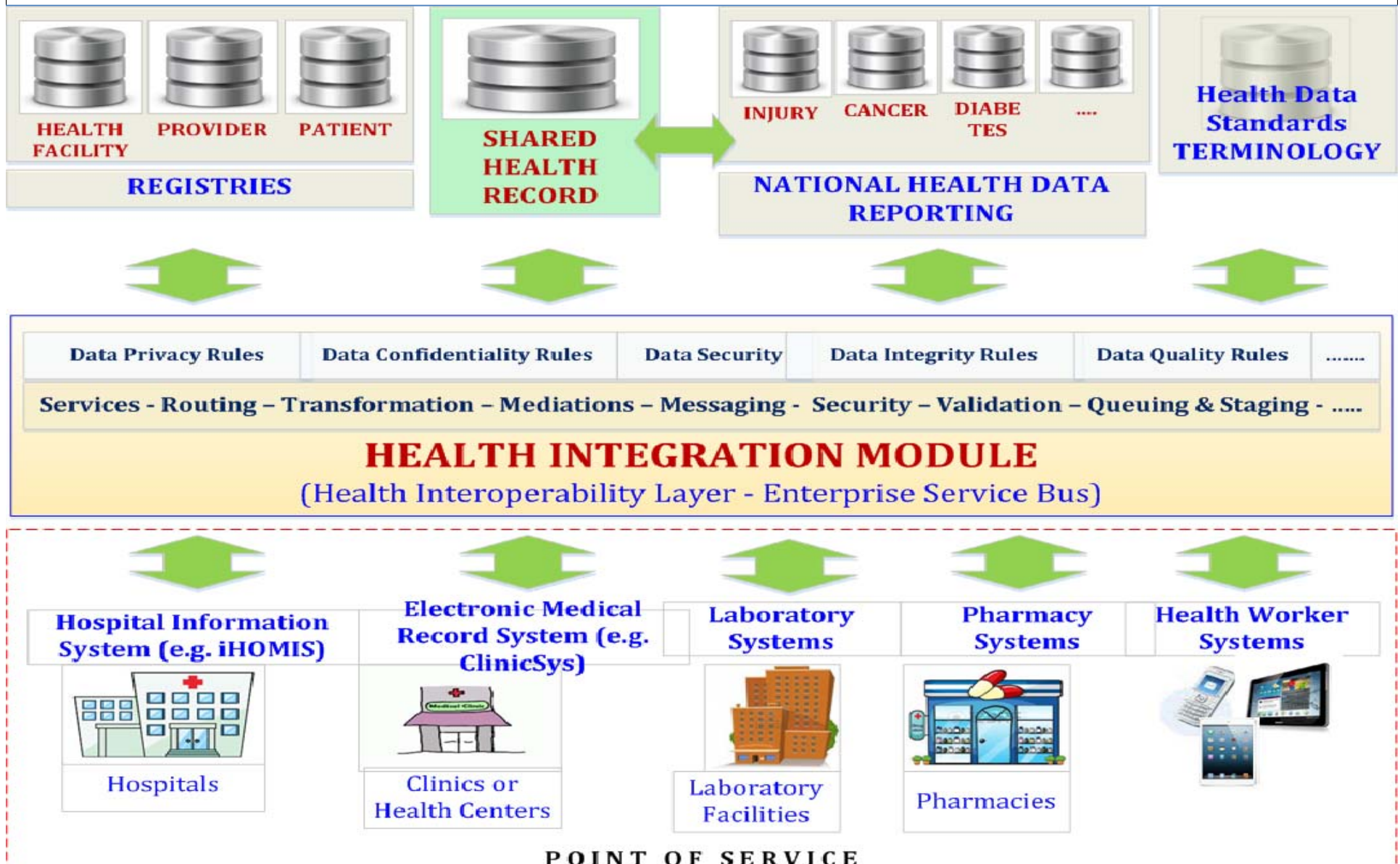
