Sharad's career in the media industry spans 47 years. He was the Director Technology of the Asia-Pacific Broadcasting Union till 2013. Sharad has previously worked as Director Engineering in Doordarshan-India, General Manager in TCIL and Professor of TV Technical Operations in the Film and TV Institute of India. Currently he is a Technical Consultant carrying out projects on TV broadcasting and

spectrum issues. He is also the Advisor on Technology and International Relations to the Chief Executive Officer of Prasar Bharati, the Indian Public Broadcaster.
