









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Training workshops under ITU Asia-Pacific CoE




- Conducted in a host country through collaboration with Nodes & Partners

- Typical duration 4 to 5 days
- Typical workshop comprises of

 - Working group exercise
 - Quiz
- Evaluation
 - Quiz (in groups)
 - Working group exercise presentation

ITU ASP COE: An Overview of face to face training




On an average 41 participants joined each face to face trainings

Quality Indicator – Is it good?






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
Online trainings under ITU Asia-Pacific CoE

- Conducted under ITU Academy platform
- Moodle based
- Average duration 4 to 6 weeks
- Comprises of
 - learning materials, reference resources
 - Discussion forums structured 1 ~2 topics per week
 - Chat sessions 1 hour per week
- Evaluation
 - Level of participation in discussion forum & chat session
 - Quiz (typically 2 in the course)
 - Assignment
 - Min 35% top qualify for certificate



ITU ASP COE: An Overview of online training





On an average of 3 online trainings ranging from 4 to 6 weeks were carried out each year.

Online courses are good to engage with wider audience but are not yet a substitute to face to face for some topics.

It is well suited for subjects that require long term interaction with experts and those involving lot of references (e.g. standards)

Average of 31 participants per training
