- ☐ Not for commercial or profit purposes or not a part of a private company.
- ☐ To educate and advance the community to archive welfare for the community by conducting programs involving culture, education, and information illustrating the identity of the people and nation.

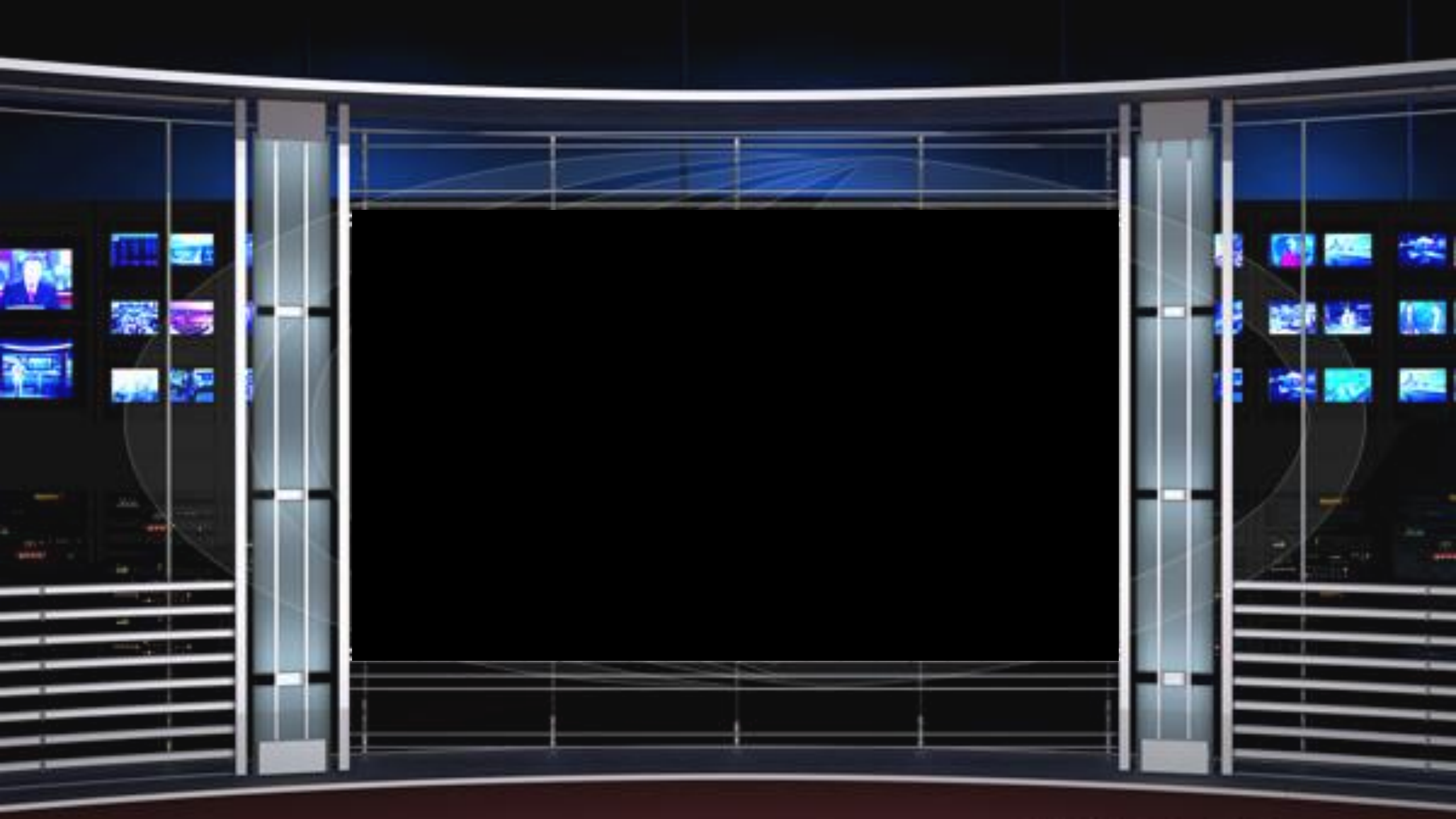


