- King: Tupou VI



### **Benefits of Satellite Communication for Tonga**



- 1. COVERAGE
  - Reach remote and underdeveloped islands
- 2. PORTABILITY AND MOBILITY
  - Inmarsat Terminals & Satellite phones
- 3. SERVICE RESTORATIONS
  - In emergency
  - LINK COST
    - Regardless of geographical location link cost does not depend on distance
- 5. SCALABILITY
  - Can be customized to Applications
  - E.g VSAT for small islands vs Standard

#### **Challenges of Satellite Communication in Tonga**

- 1. COST PER MEGABIT
  - Not Cheap compared to Fiber Optic
- 2. LATENCY
  - Typically 500+ millisecond (Geo)
  - **B. INTERFERENCE (C BAND)** 
    - With Wimax (3.5GHz)
  - 4. TROPICAL WEATHER
    - Rain Fade attenuation (Ku & Ka Band)
    - Cyclones

## **Tonga Communications Corporation**

- 1. Earth Stations (6)
  - 2 in the Main Island (Tongatapu)
  - 1 in Ha'apai Group
    - 1 in Vava'u Group
    - 1 in Niua Toputapu (remote island)
    - > 1 in Niua Fo'ou (remote island)
- 2. Capacity (UL + DL)
  - Around 26 Mbits/sec (International)
  - Around 7 Mbits/sec (Domestic)





# **Digicel Tonga**

- 1. Earth Stations (3)
  - > 1 in the Main Island (Tongatapu)
  - 1 in Ha'apai Group
  - 1 in Vava'u Group
- 2. Capacity (UL + DL)
  - Around 6 Mbits/sec (International)
  - Around 34 Mbits/sec (Domestic)





# **Orbital Slot Filings**



1. 1988 – Government established relationship with Tongasat (Friendly Islands Satellite Communications Ltd), formalized in 1994

2. Government Revenue – over US\$25m
