Session 4: Smart City Policy Framework and City-to-City Cooperation for Smart Sustainable City Development

The aim of the session will be to guide cities on how to achieve results-oriented smart sustainable city development and to promote mutually beneficial peer learning and solidarity amongst cities through city-to-city collaboration.






