I am pleased to invite your organization to participate in the face-to-face training on **"Spectrum Management and Monitoring"** to be held in in Chengdu, Sichuan Province, China, from 16 to 21 May 2016.

This face-to-face training is organized jointly by the International Telecommunication Union and the State Radio Monitoring Centre (SRMC), MIIT, China as part of the priority programme on Spectrum Management under the auspices of the ITU Centres of Excellence for Asia-Pacific region. The training will be delivered in English.
