I am pleased to invite your organization to participate in the Asia-Pacific regional workshop on "Spectrum Management: *Economic Aspects*" to be held in in Tehran, I.R. Iran, from 21<sup>st</sup> to 23<sup>rd</sup> November 2016.

The workshop is being organized jointly by the International Telecommunication Union (ITU) and the Ministry of ICT (I.R. Iran) - ICT Faculty and is being supported by Ministry of Science, ICT and Future Planning (MSIP) – Republic of Korea and Department of Communications and Arts – Australia.

This workshop is designed to address mid to senior level management from policy makers, regulators, corporate executives and managers undertaking Spectrum Management responsibilities in their respective organizations and especially its economic side. Among others, the training would focus on:

- Spectrum liberalization and Methods of incorporating economic forces and market mechanisms in SM
- Ways of ensuring access to spectrum
- Spectrum assignment and the design of spectrum auctions
- Setting up rules for secondary markets in spectrum trading
- Re-purposing and re-farming spectrum bands
- Spectrum pricing and valuation
