- All you need is a computer and internet connection
- Do not need a lot of funding to get started



Drop-shipping

- Pick your niche and create a simple web page
- Use Shopify. No coding required!
- List products from AliExpress.com and set your own price
- Start advertising
- Target global audience
- Customer will pay through Paypal or Credit Card
- Do not have to maintain inventory
- Do not need to manage customer support and delivery





Affiliate Marketing

- E-Commerce in booming in Sri Lanka
- Daraz.lk provides cash on delivery services (COD)
- Join daraz affiliate program https://www.daraz.lk/affiliates/
- Pick a niche create your own website and list products
- Again you can use Shopify
- Start advertising
- You can earn up to 11% commission on the products sold on your website
- Do not need to manage inventory



Crypto-Currency mining

- A digital currency in which encryption techniques are used to regulate the generation of units of currency and verify the funds transfer
- They operate independent of a central bank
- Bitcoin is the most popular crypto-currency
- Etherium and LiteCoins are examples of other crypto currencies
- Base on block-chain technology
- Can be used as regular money for buying goods online
- Total number of bitcoins are limited to 21 million
- You either buy a crypto-currency or you can mine using computers
- Coinbase.com is a popular crypto-currency exchange







Why business incubation?

- Helps with business plan
- Networking
- Office space and high speed internet access
- Access to funding/investors
- Helps with Intellectual Property and patents
- Marketing assistance
- Management team identification
- Market research



What is incubation?

A business incubation is a company that helps new startups companies to develop by providing services such as management training or office space



Incubators VS accelerators

- Incubators are meant for early stage startups with no revenue
- Accelerators help business go to the next level
- Accelerators generally take some equity from the startups

Programs available in Sri Lanka

 Here is the list of programs available for incubation of small businesses in Sri Lanka







- Government funded technology based startup accelerator
- Program run by the ICT Agency of Sri Lanka.
- Started in 2010
- 30 startups have been funded
- Funding is given as a grant to startups with no equity taken
- Training is provided on idea generation, legal aspects and IP laws
- They offer a grant/loan of LKR 750,000







- An initiative of Startup Sri Lanka and Infocomm Investments Pte Ltd. (IIPL)
- Program is meant for taking Sri Lankan startups to the global level
- High potential start-ups in Sri Lanka are selected
- They provide mentorship, training and market access opportunities
- Selected startups are sent to Singapore under global exchange program







- VE is a joint initiative by Blue Ocean Ventures and Indian Angel Network
- Business acceleration program
- These are the companies funded through VE



































MIT Global Startup Lab Sri Lanka

Global Startup

- GSL is a joint venture between Massachusetts Institute of technology,
 University of Moratuwa and Brandix.
- This program is the Sri Lankan chapter of the worldwide program conducted by MIT
- The program started in 2011

Y-combinator

- Founded in 2005, the world's most know incubator/accelerator
- Based in Silicon Valley
- Less than 3% acceptance rate
- Dropbox and Airbnb are Y-Combinator startups
- They have a 3 month cycle for incubation
- Provides you funding of 120,000 USD and takes 7% equity



Conclusions

- ICT business can be started with a very small budget
- Social media presence can increase exposure of a business
- Can easily setup an online store with Shopify with few clicks!
- Crowdsourcing can help some startups with funding
- Business incubators can help technology startups with office space, funding and networking
