He was ranked as a world top scholar in recycling and electrical equipment (Top 0.35% and 0.34% respectively) in 2022 by ScholarGPS. During 12 years at Mae Fah Luang University, he completed almost 40 projects and also served as an assistant to the president (2019-2023) and the head of the award-winning Circular Economy for Waste-free Thailand (CEWT) Research Center (2018-2024). He is now an assistant professor at the International College, Burapha University in Chonburi, Thailand. He is also sitting the executive committee of the Solid Waste Association of Thailand (SWAT).</p>
