



### **Components Status**

### **Immediate Political-Level Questions**

- Who pays for e-waste management (consumer or producer or shared)?
- Who manages the fees collected from consumers, producers or both?
- Should the financial and organisational mechanism for e-waste be provincially-led or should it be centrally-led?
- Will the existing regulations be revised to fit the new e-waste system or will new regulations be developed?
- Informal sector size, boosting formal recycling capacity. Are Sampah and Limbah effective?

#### **Lower-Level Technical Priorities**

- Improvement in definition of e-waste.
- Revamp of EEE product scope for EPR.
- Registration of producers with EPR, roles and responsibilities of producers.
- The above for domestic distributors.
- Scope and allocation of TCs and FCs, including material flows.
- Fee implementer / operational mechanism.
- Informal sector integration.
- EPR obligations, mgmt. plans and permits.

- 3) Continue with designing system before embarking on regulatory change.
- 4) Assigned and consistent ministry / department focal points.
- 5) Lead / joint-lead / lead and supporting political driving ministries:
  - KLHK, Komdigi, Bappenas?
