- Based on Article 32, Act of Republic Indonesia No 36 Year 1999 on Telecommunication
- Certification of telecommunication equipment is conducted based on :
 - Ministerial Regulation No 1/2015 concerning The amendment on Ministerial Regulation No 18/2014 of Certification for telecommunication equipment
 - Ministerial Regulation No 23/2016 concerning Certification Procedure for Cellular Phone, Computer Tablet and Handheld Computer
- Post market surveillance is conducted based on Ministerial Regulation No
 11/ 2017 concerning Procedure for Post Market Surveillance Implementation
