

About MCMC



MCMC is a communications and multimedia regulatory agency that regulates based on:

- Communications and Multimedia Act 1998 (CMA)
- Postal Services Act 2012 (PSA)
- Digital Signature Act 1997 (DSA)
- Strategic Trade Act 2010 (STA)

Other roles include, but not limited to the following

- responsible to ensure that all communication devices and equipment entering the Malaysian market are safe to operate, interoperable and do not cause interference
- to implement and promote the Government's national policy objectives for the communications and multimedia sector
- overseeing the new regulatory framework for the converging telecommunications and broadcasting industries and on-line activities



Legal Framework: C&I

IF CONVICTED

Section 182, CMA 98

• A person who uses any technical equipment or systems which **hinder network interoperability** commits an offence.

Section 183, CMA 98

A person who uses any technical equipment or systems which compromise public safety commits an offence.

Section 239, CMA 98


 A person who offers for supply, suppliers or has in his possession any nonstandard equipment or device commits an offence.







Issues due to non-standard devices





Degrade the quality of service received from communications service providers



Frequency interference to communication services



Purchased device may be counterfeit / cloned



Conformity Assessment Process (1)

Certification

Communication equipment shall be certified under Communications and Multimedia Act 1998 and Communication and Multimedia (Technical Standards) Regulations 2000 [Reg. 14]




The requirement also applies equipment integrated with communication modules (such as WiFi, Bluetooth, NFC, GSM, 3G, LTE or modem) for connecting to public communications network or for radio-communication.





Conformity Assessment Process (2)



Testing



Any testing laboratories (local or foreign) accredited according to ISO/IEC 17025 by a recognized accreditation body




Conformity Assessment Process (3)


Market Surveillance

The market surveillance aims to monitor continuous compliance of communication devices with the applicable technical standards and specifications enforced by MCMC





- Designated as Technical Standards Forum by the Commission pursuant to Section 94 and Section 184 of the CMA 1998
- Develop and recommend codes or standards to the Commission

CERTIFICATION & LABELLING SIRIM : CA

Communication and

Multimedia Act 1998

Communication product shall be certified by SIRIM as the Certifying Agency appointed by MCMC under the Section 186 of the CMA 1998 to ensure compliance to the applicable technical standards as enforced by MCMC

Mutual Recognition Arrangement

Malaysia has established Mutual Recognition Arrangement (MRA) for telecommunications conformity assessment with Singapore and the United States of America. Will continue to expand the MRA with other countries.

Technical Standardization

Collaborate with National Standard body, International and Regional SDOs and Academia to continue ensuring Communication devices and systems are safe and interoperable

Capacity Building

Participate in C&I training, workshop or events organized by ITU, APT or other international and regional SDOs to develop human capacity on C&I
