GMT + 5.30 hours

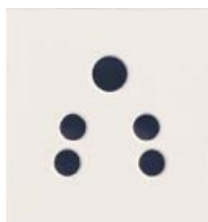
Banks & Currency

The unit of currency is Indian Rupees which comes in denominations of 1, 2, 5, 10, 20, 50, 100, 500 and 2,000. Please use authorised money changers and banks to convert currency. They will issue a certificate of exchange which is required at the time of re-conversion of any unused currency. The currency may be exchanged at the airport on arrival. Foreign Exchange Rate is approximately Rs. 69.48 Approx to US\$ 1 (as in June 2019).

Most bank ATMs honour Visa, Visa Electron, Master & Maestro cards. Most hotels, shops & other establishments accept all major international credit cards.
