He is a child protection specialist and a leading expert on child online protection.</p> <p>He has led several research studies on issues related to the protection of children in the digital age. He is also a member of the Global Advisory Group of the Sexual Violence Research Initiative and has been leading research studies on child online protection.</p> <p>He has been promoting a safer and better internet for children. He played a key role in promoting and coordinating the Safer Internet Day campaign and curating the Stop.Think.Connect movement in Nepal.</p> <p>He has developed technical and programmatic resources for advocacy, awareness, and capacity building to promote a safer and better internet for children and young people. He has worked for over thirty years in nine countries as a child protection professional with UNICEF, ILO, UN DPKO, Save the Children, ECPAT International, and Plan International.
