Srey Oeun graduated with a master's degree in social policy and social development at The Hong Kong Polytechnic University.</p>
	<p>With her passion for the environment and sustainable development, Srey Oeun had become a representative of Cambodian Youth in tiger conservation efforts and was named as Tiger Ambassador of WWF Cambodia in 2010. She was a nominee for the Women's Leadership Academy Program for Young Southeast Asian Leaders Initiative (YSEALI) and became the country leader of Cambodia's YSEALI Women Leadership Alumni in 2018. In addition, she was a representative of civil society to participate in "ASEAN in 2017 and beyond-life (re)starts at fifty" in 2017. She was the chair lady for the "Lady Saving Group", a self-help group.
