I am pleased to invite you to participate in the **workshop on Regional Cooperation of Startup Ecosystems as a Key Factor of Digital Economy Growth**, which is organized by the International Telecommunication Union (ITU) and will be held **from 15 to 16 October 2019** in **Tashkent, Republic of Uzbekistan**, at the kind invitation of the Ministry for Development of Information Technologies and Communications of the Republic of Uzbekistan.

The workshop is organized for CIS and neighboring countries and aimed at sharing experiences and expert knowledge in the field of startup development. Also, this event will give startups an opportunity to find partners for regional expansion and fundraising in neighboring countries.

The workshop will discuss the following issues:

- Infrastructure, funding and education for startups (accelerators, incubators, techno parks, educational programs etc.)
- Role of regulator in creating enabling environment for startup growth at national level and regional expansion
- Successful startups interested in expansion to CIS and neighboring markets
- Search of partners to enable regional expansion
- Creation of a permanent platform for cooperation between startup ecosystems.

The workshop will be conducted in Russian and English with simultaneous interpretation.
