I am pleased to invite you to participate in the **Forum "Smart Sustainable Cities: past, present and future"** organized by the International Telecommunication Union (ITU), which will be held in Minsk, Belarus, from 19 to 20 April 2023. The Forum will be held as part of the International specialized exhibition and congress on telecommunications, information and banking technologies Tibo 2023. At the kind invitation of the Ministry of Communications and Informatization of the Republic of Belarus and OJSC Giprosvjaz, the event will be held at the Minsk-Arena, Victory Avenue 111, Minsk, Belarus.
