

**Report of the Opening of the Iygilik Information and Training Centre
For Persons with Disabilities
Bishkek, Kyrgyz Republic, 22 October 2015**

The Iygilik Information and Training Centre for Persons with Disabilities, created by the Institute of Electronics and Telecommunications (IET) under Kyrgyz State Technical University named after Iskhak Razzakov within the framework of implementation of CIS regional initiative approved by WTDC-14: Ensuring access to telecommunications/ICT services for persons with disabilities, was opened in the IET premises in the city of Bishkek on 22 October 2015.

The Centre possess all necessary conditions for continuation of school education and mastering different professions by persons with disabilities: the building is equipped with wheelchair ramp, which enables access to the centre for persons with disabilities. In the classroom, there are multimedia means, office automation equipment, interactive whiteboard, and working places equipped with special gadgets for visually impaired and motor impaired users.



The opening ceremony was attended by Mr. Valery Dil, Vice Prime Minister of Kyrgyz Republic; Ms. Elvira Sariyeva, Minister of Education and Science of Kyrgyz Republic; and Mr. Turatbek Duyshenaliyev, Rector, KSTU; and Mr. Dastan Bekeshev, deputy of Kyrgyz Parliament, who is a visually impaired person.



Of the 12 working places available in the Centre, 6 are meant for motor impaired users and 6 – for visually impaired users. Within the framework of the opening ceremony, each working place was briefly presented.
