URGENT ACTIONS

- MUX A
 - TO ESTABLISH CORPORATION TO RUN MUX A
 - CORPORATION TO IMPLEMENT THE PROJECT ON MW AND TRANSMITTERS IN FULL
- MUX B AND C
 - TO GIVE POWER TO CRA FOR
 - SELECTING MUX OPERATOR(S)
 - IMPLEMETING DECISION ON SELECTION

FREQUENCY PLANNING

- UNTIL ONE OF TWO MUXIPLEXERS START OPERATIONS:
 - KEEP TV STATIONS ALIVE AS LONG AND AS MUCH AS POSSIBLE
 - MOVE TV STATIONS FROM FREQUENCIES WHICH INTERFERE AND DO NOT COMPLY WITH GE-06 TO MORE SUITABLE AND POSSIBLY COORDINATED FREQUENCIES
- DVB-T2?-THE WAY OUT FOR PROVISIONING TO ALL EXISTING TV STATIONS BROADCAST IN DIGITAL

LICENCING

- Legislative for digital terrestrial broadcast is ready
 - All existing TV station will be licenced for digital broadcast
 - MUX operators will have possibility to contract TV stations based on ranking list explained in previous presentation
- Current must carry obligation for CATV will remain even there's no real radio coverage
 - By this CRA wishes to maintain media landscape established 14 years ago

NEW SERVICES

- At the moment new services may be seen on other platforms only:
 - Satellite
 - Cable
 - Telecom networks
 - IPTV
