

# RNIB Audio Description App Project

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# Three-month trial of the app

## Focus

- Explore user preferences of audio description users with respect to this new delivery method
- Establish its suitability for use with on-demand services

## Timeline

- February – May 2015

## Content for testing

- Films and TV dramas

# Participants

- 198 users of audio description

## Eligibility for participation

- 18 years or older
- Either blind or partially sighted
- UK residents
- Existing regular users of audio description
- Existing users of video on-demand services
- Existing users of smartphones or tablets

# Participant profile

- 66 per cent identified themselves as blind
- 71 per cent between 25 – 64 years (even spread)
- 93 per cent used the app on a smartphone
- 88 per cent used app on iOs exclusively
- 83 per cent were screen reader users
- Other services used by our participants on a smartphone:  
shopping, reading, research, social media etc
