The main directions of activities are set out in the National Program of Integrated Informatization (NPiI)

The creation of a Identity Scheme is one of the main objectives (NPiI)

One public sector central information website provides a single point of access to public eGov Services

New public eGov Services

eID and mID: Federated model of electronic identification

Integration and opening of state registers

Digitalization of public offices

The creation of the Competence Center for e-Government

Assumptions of the National Electronic Identification Scheme

Federated system, allowing various Identity Providers from private (eg. Banks, Telecoms, Postal) and public sector

Implementation of a Domestic node based on Cross-Border eIDAS node, acting as Identity Broker for local eGovernment services

Implementation of cross-border node based on EU source-code

Identity Office, which supervision Identity Scheme and providers

The new law defining a shape of the entire system

Two separate projects which covers eID and mID: former focused on eIDAS implementation, latter focused on new innovative mobile identification

eID:

- Cross-border node implemented on production with CEF financing and open-source code (fall 2016)
- Domestic node will be implemented in Q3 2017 with e-government baseline services (fully automated)
- Banks credentials will be used for public ID and signature registration (Profil Zaufany) starting October 2016

mID:

- Vision and requirements are about to be finished and closed (Fall 2016) for simple implementation based on token/OTP
- Advanced innovative mID is scheduled to be released in 2019 (tbc)

What we want to do?

- The creation of ITU Expert Group within the Regional Initiatives program for Europe.

Who?

- The Republic of Poland and ITU in cooperation with experts in the field of Mobile Identity.

How?

- It is expected that experts would share knowledge about current Mobile Identity implementations, discuss specific limitations of certain architectures, business models and offer expertise and knowledge in selected areas like security or awareness raising campaigns.

Project goal

The aim to the project is to:

- gather information about innovative Mobile Identity solutions and technologies,
- gain knowledge about successful information campaigns,
- share ideas, exchange best practices and findings between members of ITU with a clear focus on Mobile Identity,
- create a summary report for ITU community about Mobile Identity and raise interest and awareness in this area.

Project Description

Phase I

Expert Group meeting on best practices in implementation of mID.

This meeting gives a possibility to review global best practices, technologies, architecture, security and business issues. It also includes limitations of different types of mID solutions and the aspect of awareness raising and informational campaign.

The result of this meeting will be the overview of best practices prepared in a form of a report.

- Date: 18-19 of October 2016
- Number of participants: representatives indicated by Polish Ministry of Digital Affairs, at least 10 countries.

In-depth analysis of selected issues addressed in Phase I will be done in the next step. Preferably mid December 2016.

Project Description

Phase II

This phase is a follow-up to the Expert Group meeting and will depend on the outcomes of the October meeting and on the result of further analysis.

The next step will be the creation of a concept and component of an information campaign for awareness raising with the ITU assistance. The component will be developed on the basis of the knowledge gained in the first and second phase.

The final project (preferably an audiovisual material and brochures) will be available for use in other countries implementing such mID solutions.

- Completion date: January-March 2017.

What project offers to participants

Expert Group Meetings offer perfect forum to share ideas, thoughts, best practices about past, current and future Mobile Identity solutions.

Currently there is a variety of Mobile Identity versions, eg. based on application, sim or token, and it would be beneficial to all ITU Member States to share information about limitations, advantages, business models which were applied successfully, and future plans and privacy issues.

Having the meeting broadcasted will also give opportunity for remote participation to all interested countries around the world.

The Expert Group will create a summary report for ITU community about Mobile Identity and raise interest and awareness in this area
