

Number of training activities implemented per year, all regions, as of December 2017





Courses implemented per region per year (December 2017)





Implementation Status CoE courses for all regions - December 2017




Europe Region, CoE training courses (December 2017)







Publication "Capacity Building in a Changing ICT Environment"




- Online publication recently released

 - Will be published in second quarter 2018






- Number of training activities implemented per year

Selection of CoEs for the next cycle



- Scheduled to be done in 2018
- New CoEs to begin to operate in 2019
- Process to be followed in this selection will be guided by reviews being undertaken such as the review of the OPP
- The conclusion of WTDC-2017 has provided some of the needed inputs into this process



WTDC-17



- Attended by 1360 participants, including 134 member states, 83
 public and private sector entities, 41 telecommunication entities,
 22 regional and international organizations
- ITU-D contribution to the ITU Strategic Plan and ITU-D Action Plan for the next 4 years was adopted
- Regional Initiatives were agreed
- Strategic objectives and Regional Initiatives will be part of the information used to determine priority areas for CoEs
- Resolution 40 (GCBI) and Resolution 73 (CoEs) were updated

EUR1: Broadband infrastructure, broadcasting and spectrum management

EUR2: A citizen-centric approach to building services for national administrations

EUR3: Accessibility, affordability and skills development for all to ensure digital inclusion and sustainable development
