

#### **Transportation**

The easiest journey from the Vaclav Havel Airport is by a taxi. There are stands directly in front of the Exit at the airport.

Public transportation is possible by the bus and metro. For the shortest route please take the **bus No. 119** (bus stop just in front of Exit) **going to the Veleslavin nadrazi** (the final stop). There you have to change for the metro line A (green one) going to **Mustek**. At Mustek you may leave the metro and continue 10 minutes on foot or change the line A for line B to **namesti Republiky**.

## Visa

#### Without Visa:

• citizens of the EU, Iceland, Norway, Lichtenstein, and Switzerland stay temporarily in the territory of the Czech Republic without any permit on the basis of a travel document or an identity card.
