A high-level round table on "Enabling Environment for 5G" is organized jointly by ITU and BEREC within the framework of the 5G Techritory: 2nd Baltic Sea Region 5G Ecosystem Forum and in context of the ITU Regional Initiative for Europe on Broadband Infrastructure, Broadcasting and Spectrum Management, adopted by the World Telecommunication Development Conference 2017 (WTDC-17), Buenos Aires.

The main objective of this meeting is to discuss recent trends, challenges and opportunities related to the 5G deployment and commercialization in Europe as well as worldwide. Special attention will be dedicated to the role of regulators in fostering investment, innovation, and business models. Meeting will benefit from a special update on the outcomes of the ITU World Radiocommunication Conference (Sharmel Sheik, 2019), expected to take strategic decisions affecting dynamics of 5G roll-out world-wide.

This round table is open to top-level policymakers, regulators, heads of major industry organizations, business leaders, and other stakeholders. Multistakeholder character of this roundtable will ensure diversity in perspectives. Opening remarks will be provided by Mr Jaroslaw Ponder, Head of the Europe Office, ITU and Mr Jeffrey Godfrey, Chairman, BEREC and will set context of discussions.
