






Systematic inclusion of accessibility in all public procurement agreements

Accessibility integrated in Procurement?

Law implemented understood? Are there targets, responsabilites? Risks / opportunities monitored? Are there resources, knowledge? Non-users involved in design? Monitoring, complaints? Performance evaluation?

Systematic inclusion of accessibility

- Accessibility in all purchases from copy machine to new system
- Ensure targets, support and knowledge in the organisation
- Actively involve "non-users" from the outset to identify needs, in design, testing compliance, evaluation etc
- Give guidance on methods for active involvement and use cases
- Use Award criteria to ensure quality of supplier (EN17161)
- Consider innovation procurement
- Learn by doing and improve the procurement strategy
