What is the Zero Project?

- An initiative of the Essl Foundation
- Mission: “For a World without Barriers”
- Identify and promote Innovative Practices and Innovative Policies covering:
 - Accessibility
 - Education
 - Employment
 - Independent Living and Political Participation
- Applying “crowd intelligence” by using a network of over 5.000 experts with and without disabilities from more than 180 countries, across all sectors
