GARI was created in 2008 by the Mobile & Wireless Forum (MWF) to provide information on accessibility features in mobile phones and to help consumers identify devices that support these features. The GARI site (www.gari.info) features an evolving searchable database that currently has information on more than 130 accessible features and over 1,500 devices (including mobile phones, tablets, Smart TVs, Wearables and apps) around the world in many languages. The objective is to create one central source of information for global accessibility solutions in the mobile ecosystem. The use of GARI is free of charge and offers advantages for: 1) Consumers - a comprehensive searchable database of phones and features in multiple languages; 2) Governments- a feature set that is far more extensive than any country's existing requirements; 3) Manufacturers - report it once and have it accepted everywhere.
