Accessibility Plus Programme - a comprehensive programme of Polish government providing multifaceted, systemic and coordinated activities in the field of accessibility. These activities aim at improving quality of living and providing the independence of life for people with disabilities and other people with specific needs, including the elderly and persons with permanent or temporary difficulties in mobility or perception. It is to be achieved through the large-scale improvement in public space accessibility, including architecture, transport, products and services. Digital and ICT accessibility is one of the pillars of the Programme.

In July 2018, Polish government launched the Accessibility Plus Program – a multi-annual program that aims to improve the quality of infrastructure and integrate accessibility issues permanently into all public policies in Poland. It is one of the few and very ambitious programs of this type in Europe. After a year of implementing, the Program proved to be very successful in terms of increasing social awareness of the concept and importance of accessibility and through specific projects implemented so far.
