




Challenges for Ukraine in the field of Children Internet Safety





First Steps



- → Establishing of leading point at the national level

Training	Obligatory training of teacher and pupils at schools
Services	Psychological support hotline for children, parents and teachers on the use of the Internet by children*

Protection from sexual abuse and exploitation on the Internet

State	State coordination of children protection from sexual abuse and exploitation on the Internet
Legislation	Legislative changes on sexual crimes against children on the Internet
Awareness campaigns	Awareness campaigns for parents, teachers and children about Internet safety and Internet addiction of parents and children
Services	Creation of a national system for interviewing victims Creation of services for the victim rehabilitation Service of removal of photo/video materials of children sexual abuse – IWF*
Research	Conducting research

Pornography

State	Legislative changes on the storage and viewing of child sexual abuse imagery
Awareness campaigns	Awareness campaigns and educational events for the industry, deputies, adults and media in order to introduce greater restrictions on the access of children to pornographic materials; Increasing of parents' awareness about the impact of pornographic materials on the child and existing parental controls
Services	Setting safe for children filtering WiFi in public places (FriendlyWiFi); Increasing the number of available parental controls from Internet providers
Research	Surveys among teenagers and their parents on viewing pornographic materials
