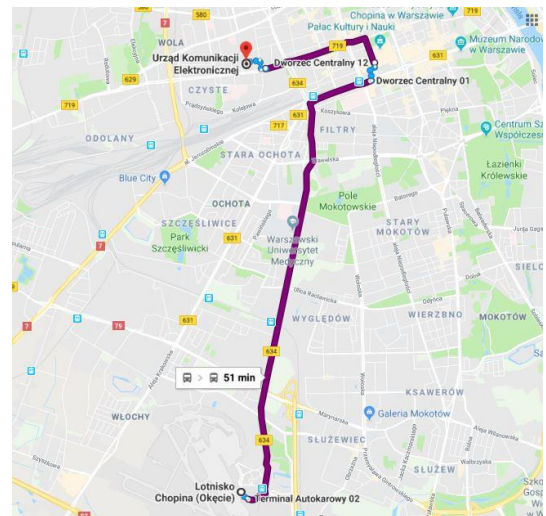
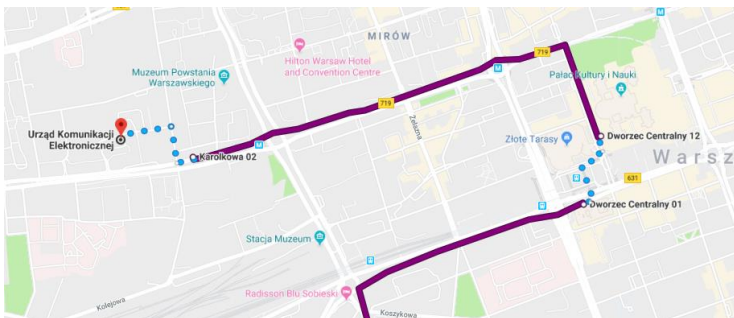

Public transport

Bus No 175 operates between Warsaw Chopin Airport and City Center, it runs daily between 04:27 - 22:58. Route: Take the bus 175 from the Chopin Airport to City Centre (Central Railway Station), then change to bus 109 goes in the direction "Os.Górczewska" or bus 171 goes in the direction "Chomiczówka". Get off on the "Karolkowa" bus stop. UKE is in walking distance (approx. 5 min.).

7. Currency and payment methods

The official Polish currency unit is zloty, abbreviated as PLN. The average currency rate in relation to Euro is 4.28 PLN for 1 EUR. Foreign currencies may be changed into Polish zlotys at banks, private exchange offices (called “kantor” in Polish) or hotels. Major travelers’ cheques can be changed and all major credit cards are widely accepted. Official exchange rate of PLN against foreign currencies could be found on www.nbp.pl/Kursy/KursyC.html

Credit Cards - The most hotels, restaurants, car rental agencies, department stores and shops are accepting major credit cards (American Express, Visa, Eurocard, Master Card).

Poland uses 230 V, 50 Hz. Plugs are two-pin continental size (type E, the socket also works with plug C and plug F if it has an additional pinhole).
