HOW?

-Create new pool of regional experts who will spread the relevant expertise within their national, sub-regional and regional environments.

- Regional SG1 Vice-Chairs should contribute to initiating regional partnerships towards strengthening and/or identifying collaboration with Study Group work, to raise awareness, encourage and attract additional ITU members.
