








#### Scoreboard EU 27+UK: significant progress made since June 2019
















### Scoreboard EU 27+UK: September 2020 spectrum figures



5G spectrum – EU-27+UK (22 September 2020)

- 26.4% of spectrum assigned compared to 14.2% in June 2019
- The 3.6 GHz band assignment is progressing with more auctions in 2020
- In specific cases, spectrum has been assigned but cannot be used in 2020


**26.4%** 5G spectrum assigned throughout the EU-27 plus the UK\*



<sup>\*</sup> represents the total amount of spectrum assigned in all 27 Member States and in the UK. The figure is expected to increase following the recently updated EU telecom rules.






### Major commercial launches in Europe: 5G live in 18 markets



- 18 EU 27 countries + UK
- 30+ players
- Almost all 5G networks use the 3.6 GHz band
- The 2.1 GHz also used

## No global 5G killer app...too early to define and will be country-specific



- Often higher speeds and data throughputs
- 5G FWA / 5G mobile services
- Mostly B2C/eMBB services: UHD video, AR/VR, gaming/entertainment, education, virtual communications
- 5G services pushed by the Covid-19 pandemic
  - Virtual office / virtual education with holograms/AR/VR
  - eHealth services
  - Aided diagnosis
  - Robotics treatment/remote care/medical IoT
  - Security
  - AR/VR aided surgery
  - Collecting patient data

#### **Conclusions**



- 5G deployments are under way in the EU: 16 countries with 5G commercial services
- Spectrum assignments: 25.5% of spectrum assigned in the three pioneer bands compared to 14.2% in June 2019
- The Covid-19 pandemic delayed 5G by a few months in some countries:
  - Cellular networks have successfully coped with increased traffic requirements
  - The Covid-19 increased awareness of the need of digital sollutions, incl. Telehealth, teleworking

#### But

- Spectrum auctions in a number of countries were delayed by a few months....
- Delayed auctions are now completed or imminent
- •Freeze of Release 16 was postponed to June 2020 and Release 17 likely to be postponed as well
- Some deployments or investments were delayed
