1. Online Virtual Meeting

Platform: Interprefy

Login: Please follow this link on a supported web browser to enter the virtual meeting room: <u>Virtual Meeting</u> <u>Portal</u>. Log in with ITU account or TIES credentials and enter the virtual meeting.

General guidance:

- Supported web browsers: **Google Chrome, Firefox** or **Microsoft Edge** (79+) note that Internet Explorer is NOT a supported browser. **Google Chrome** is the recommended choice. Please ensure that you have downloaded the most up-to-date version of your browser ;
- It is not recommended to use tablets and mobile devices;
- Please shut down any other application that might be using your microphone and/or camera (SfB, Teams, Zoom, etc.) if you plan to take the floor;
- Please use a **headset**, especially during interventions (it prevents echo). The use of video when making an intervention is optional;
- Kindly ensure you are not on a VPN;
- To log into Interprefy, please use the username and not the email;
- Please use the same user account that you used to register.
