International Telecommunication Union (hereafter: ITU) plays an essential role as a platform for international community that allows us to coordinate on global objectives and development of necessary tools for effective implementation of actions that support countries that seek such assistance. At the same time we recall ITU Constitution that states in its preamble on the growing importance of telecommunication for the preservation of peace and the economic and social development of all States. The very objective that shall come into consideration shall include not being limited to: common access to a high-speed Internet, effective and use-friendly public eservices and a continuously rising level of digital competences of the society

As for Republic of Poland over 450 days ago we have initiated many simultaneous projects to support Ukraine in establishing resilient digital environment with respect to the efforts of the United Nations to promote sustainable development, in particular aiming at achieving Sustainable Development Goal 16 on Peace, Justice and Strong Institutions.

Within scope of Partner2Connect Poland has donated Ukraine with hundreds of pallets with equipment that included radio stations, data centres, IT equipment and over 20 000 Starlink terminals with all service expenses covered. Outside of this scope we have signed Memorandum's on strenghtening common cooperation regarding cybersecurity, social benefits, access to labour market and we support coordination of deliveries to Ukraine from over 50 countries.

Republic of Poland wishes to take this opportunity to reconfirm our commitment to the process as we recognize that additional actions are required.





In the recent years Republic of Poland has been a beneficiary of significant support provided through EU programmes, enabling rapid roll-out of high-speed Internet access networks, due to which the digital divide has been bridged. Therefore Poland would be pleased to share experiences and know-how in that area within the scope of ITU initiatives, which might be useful for Ukraine in the process of establishing national mechanisms for effective use of financial support provided by international community for rehabilitation of ICT infrastructure.
