The UNDP launched a Digital Transformation in the Public Sector Project in Bosnia and Herzegovina in 2020, aiming to support governments and institutions at all levels to undergo a digital transformation, enhancing capacities for transparent and effective policymaking, knowledge, and resource management, and ultimately leading to accelerated development results, government accountability, and digital delivery of people-centered public services.

As one of our flagship initiatives, we are developing a scalable and interoperable information management system for the one-stop-shop public service delivery tailored to administrative procedures and mandates of governments and institutions in Bosnia and Herzegovina. Together with piloting transactional e-services and integrating developed and tested digital solutions, we aim to create a Public Service Design Toolkit – a repository of principles, standards, requirements, and technical specifications for the design, development, and delivery of public e-Services, including through this portal. To ensure full compliance of this practical national guide with relevant international standards and best practices, we plan to closely cooperate with ITU through the GovStack initiative, particularly in exchanging knowledge and peer collaboration.
