TITLE: Establishment of the Western Balkans Cyber Capacity Center (WB3C)

DESCRIPTION OF ACTION:

Slovenia and France are partnering up with Montenegrin Government to establish a regional Western Balkans Cyber Capacity Centre (WB3C) / Centre de développement des Capacités Cyber des Balkans Occidentaux (3CBO) that will be hosted in Podgorica. The project enjoys great support from all WB6 countries.

Support to the Western Balkans countries through increased cooperation and training in the field of cybersecurity and cybercrime will address pertinent regional shortcomings.

The regional centre will cover three aspects of operational expert training: Cybersecurity, Fight against Cybercrime and Cyber diplomacy and will contribute to the exchange of information and good practices.

The training courses aim to disseminate a cyber-culture, develop the expertise of active practitioners and create a regional cooperation network.

The centre will also aim to introduce cyber curriculum in the universities of the region, through the cooperation with the academic institutions from Slovenia and France.
