What is a new mCitizen 2.0

The law came into force on July 14

mCitizen 2.0 is:

- a new version of the already well-known mCitizen app,
- moving away from the digital wallet concept for documents for the citizen's assistant
- ensuring compliance with the eIDAS 2 in progress



A milestone in the current development of mCitizen 2.0 was the entry into force of the law on mCitizen

mldentity Card, the new identity document - ability to verify identity when dealing with official and other matters

Electronic identification means integrated with national node

Document wallet and services for the citizen

Partner for municipalities in the area of issuing their own documents in the mCitizen application





And then there is much, much more ...


- Documents evidencing the right to practice a medical profession
- Temporary driving licence
- Withholding a PESEL number
- Payments
- Power of attorneys



mCitizen 2.0 already has certain features of the EU Wallet

- Peer-to-peer authentication (storage, presentation and transmission for verification of mobile documents)
- Downloading user data from public records and systems directly to the user's device
- Transferring data under the user's control to verified entities (public and private)
- Enabling private entities to provide services in the application
- New electronic identification means mCitizen profile









Six-month work on mCitizen 2.0 included a series of research initiatives.



5 usability tests

2 quantitative studies

200 citizens take part in research




