

EVALUATION

 Based on Processes and Procedures document by the ITU headquarters

SELECTION

- Considered by GCBI
- Selected by the BDT Director
- Endorsed by TDAG





Provision of individual certificates







Governance: SC meetings

SC members announced 1 month after the CoEs selection

Annually rotating chairmanship

ITU is a secretariat

Meeting – 4th quarter of the year

Every meeting includes 2 parts:

- General
- Decision-making

Notice of the meeting shall be sent 2 months before the meeting.



Implementation Timeframe

Present CoEs continue functioning till 2015

After WTDC-14 topics will be selected and an invitation to apply will be sent

Processes and Procedures document will be translated and sent before WTDC-14

New WTDC cycle starts from January 2015 and will implement the New Strategy
