- Professional training courses are generally **not** profit making activities
 - ▶ minimum of 6-8 delegates to break even
 - ▶ chance to share time and knowledge and get to know clients and potential clients – a **two-way** exchange of knowledge and issues
 - ▶ training on hardware/software part of the sale and commissioning process
- Training often forms part of a wider institutional development program within a project
 - ▶ adds significant value, especially to developing regulators
- Stella Artois effect (*reassuringly expensive*)



What is needed for industry to accept ITU training programmes?

- Embracing of the importance and value of industry-based training in addition to academic training
 - ▶ play to each other's strengths
- Recognition of the time, effort and IPR embedded in existing course materials
 - ▶ industry is not going to give away material
- Accreditation of industry-based courses by ITU
- Integrated CPD system for ITU/Academic/Industry courses
- Co-ordinated timetabling to minimise clashes

What would ITU/Academia gain?

- Joint marketing with a larger budget
- Wider selection of course material
 - ▶ Highly specialised modules
- Existing, prepared courses
 - ▶ No duplication of effort
- Increased opportunities to generate revenue for ITU/Academia
- Access to real-world experience and skills, and hands-on access to hardware and software
